

BIT CASE for May 5th

Dining Staff

Monday afternoon, a male student was eating at the Benson Center and left some personal trash in a white plastic bag on top of his finished food plate. One of the staff from the dining center cleaned the table and did a quick check on the bag. There was a student the previous week who left a wallet on their plate and the staff was just being extra careful. In the box, they found the packaging from a gun magazine. The staff brought this to the staff who runs the student welfare team (they are in the same building).

Campus Safety Services

Campus Safety received a call from a Benson Center building manager about some weapon accessory packaging left behind as trash in the dining hall. CSS was able to find security camera footage of the student and circulated the picture among the CSS staff. One of the officers recognized the student as Charlie Davidson.

Residence Life

Campus Safety called the professional staff member for the University Villas to find out more information about Charlie Davidson, a junior living in the University Villas. The staff person knows Charlie Davidson as someone who has been having some on-going difficulties with stress, odd social interactions, and difficulty with losing his access card/keys on several occasions. He hasn't been doing well in classes this semester and he has been wandering the apartment building worried and complaining about this.

Drahmann Center

In close time proximity to all of this, OSL receives a Student of Concern report from a staff person in Drahmann about Charlie Davidson. The report states that he has used tutoring services on several occasions and recently had some difficult conversations with one of the academic tutors over the hours of the center and the expectation to give at least a two day turn around on receiving help and edits for a paper the student has written. The conversation went back and forth a number of times. The staff member said that the incident has been dealt with and considered it to be resolved. However, the staff member wanted to inform OSL because there are rumors via the student staff in Drahmann that Charlie has been problematic elsewhere on campus.

Counseling and Psychological Services

Charlie has been going to CAPS for most of the quarter and he has been trying to manage stress about completing his academic work. He has also presented with odd logic and speech, as well as a general distractedness and inattention when being asked questions. He denies thinking about killing himself currently but talks about a darkness that follows him. He usually is seen weekly but has not come in for his past two sessions. His therapist sent an email and voicemail to check in with no response.

One Stop - Financial Services

Charlie Davidson showed up at One Stop a week ago complaining about the nature of his aid package and why his tuition cost so much when there wasn't a guarantee that he would be able to earn this money back. He said to the person at the counter, "Like, there is no guarantee, so why do you get a guarantee to get the money back? If I get the money, you get the money, right?" They offered to schedule a time to talk with him more, but he said he didn't have time for that and left abruptly. No Student of Concern report was filed.

Social Media

On the open Facebook page of Charlie Davidson, there are a number of pictures of weapons, Charlie shooting at the range, and posts with themes of depression. There are some traveling pictures of NYC and San Francisco.
